
## Woodlands 2019 Preview

Harvesting CP 41 - 5 blocks totaling approx.16,000m3 up Cooper Face by Sunshine Logging. Species profile is SxHwLwFdCw. There is a spruce tonewood component in the permit that will be sold locally. Local mills at the north end of Kootenay Lake will also be contacted to purchase timber for their mills.





- Building approximately 2km of road on the Nashton face by a local contractor.
- Work on a Business Plan to guide our planning over the next 10 years. The work on the business plan involves a timber sustainability review and exploring alternate sources of revenue and business ventures.
- Landscape Level Wildfire Protection Plan (LLWPP): scheduled for completion October 31.

• Fuel treatment layout and applying for grant money for Wildland Urban Interface work in 2020.



- Timber development will be focused in the Nashton area. Fire interface layout will take place in the southern end of Shutty Bench and Branch 7 area above Kaslo. This layout will be guided by the KDCFS LLWPP and Area D 2016 CWPP.
- The Forest Stewardship Plan (FSP) will be completed later this spring. Open House planned for July to discuss FSP, LLWPP and other community consultation.
- Monitoring the Douglas-fir beetle epidemic that has spread from the Boundary to the Nelson area. Bark beetle surveys will be conducted in at risk stands.



• Continued information sharing with the BC Community Forest Association (BCCFA) and other Community Forests on fire interface work, climate change strategies in adaptive harvesting and silviculture methods.
