

WOODLANDS

Briggs Creek

Approximately 22,300m3 has been shipped until the end of November from the fire salvage operations in CPs 51, 52 and 53. Sicotte continues to ship wood from Keen Creek, with another 2000m3 projected to bring the year up close to 25,000m3.

Timber development will continue up Keen Creek in the New Year, laying out the additional blocks for potential harvest in 2024.

Blocks and roads will be developed up Lost Ledge over the winter with the focus being getting access towards the edge of the bench above Lardeau.

INTERNAL

WILDFIRE RISK REDUCTION

The crew has finished on the Mt Buchanan access project (KAS 6) for the year as snow has made access difficult. They were able to clean up TUs 1-B, H and J. Work on the Jimi Crack Corn project started on Monday. Due to the flat ground and fairly thick canopy closure providing safer working conditions in the snow, the crew will be able to work on this project for the next few months.
