## Management Report Presented Jeff Reyden

**Q:** What is your overall view of the heath of our community forest after the Briggs Creek fire? **A:** We're busy laying out cutblocks. We have around 200 hectares developed with more area to look at this year. We are looking at harvesting about 35,000 cubic metres in 2023. Harvesting the fire-damaged timber is a longterm timber supply incentive. We'll get to what we can that's

merchantable, which will shift our harvesting from green timber to firedamaged timber that would otherwise disappear. The total area that will be developed for harvesting represents around 10% of the total area that was burnt. Harvesting these areas will make for more expedient and easier reforestation as well. Ministry of Forests maps from aerial surveys showed that the tenure wasn't badly affected, but field trips showed the extent of the damage.

Q: What about old growth?

**A:** The fire burned about 10 hectares of old-growth trees. About 15% of our operable area is old growth

Q: Any new projects covered by grants?

**A:** We have a grant to do some thinning on a block up Branch 7, but they may not get to it this year due to having to focus on fire salvage operations.
